**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE,  
TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2, OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF WYOMING**

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered in open session the modification of the Liquor Control Ordinance with respect to the addition of a class of liquor licenses for special events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By The City Council of the CITY OF WYOMING, STARK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, As Follows:

SECTION ONE. That Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 55 is amended by the addition of sub-paragraph (F) to read and shall be as follows:

Sec. 3-2-55. License classifications; fees established; number of licenses.

(F) CLASS F LICENSES. Special Event Licenses shall authorize the retail sale of beer and wine only during a special event that occurs not more often than semi-annually, sponsored by a not-for-profit corporation or association and conducted by such association or corporation. This license shall not issue for more than two consecutive days nor for more than 12 hours during any single day. No license fee shall be charged for this license. Prior to the issuance of a Class "F" license, the sponsoring organization shall furnish to the City a certificate or other policy of Dram Shop Insurance insuring the City of Wyoming and its agents and employees. There shall be no limit on the number of Class "F" licenses.

SECTION TWO. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication as provided by law.



**AN ORDINANCE** Amending the Open Burning Ordinance in the  
**CITY OF WYOMING**, Stark County, Illinois  
[Amendment of City Code 7-6-4]

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has considered in open session amendment to the Open Burning Ordinance in the City;

**AND, WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that open burning near the Stark County Grade School during times school is in session has caused health problems for some of the children attending the school and should be prohibited;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, Be It Ordained by the City Council of the **CITY OF WYOMING**, Stark County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section One:** That Title 7, Chapter 6, Section 4 of the Wyoming City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**Section 5.:** The burning of landscape waste shall be permitted only in compliance with the requirements of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and the rules and regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board and the IEPA, and shall be subject to the following restrictions:

- (A) Only on the premises on which waste is generated,
- (B) Only if attended at all times,
- (C) Only between 8:00 a.m. and dusk,
- (D) Only leaves and tree limbs can be burned, not grass,
- (E) Not during times of excessive winds,
- (F) Not during drought conditions which present an excessive risk for spreading of the open fire,

- (G) Not during a water shortage or other emergency,
- (H) Not before 4:00 p.m. on any day school is in session within a two (2) block radius of the Stark County Grade School.

**Section Two:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalid or unenforceable section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

**Section Three:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication as provided by law.




