Council Meeting

The Regular Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Pat Maher at 5:59 p.m. Those in attendance pledged their Allegiance to the Flag. The Wyoming Illinois City Council met Tuesday, December 05, 2023, at the Paramount Theater located at 104 S. 7th Street, Wyoming IL. Roll call was taken and Alderpersons Dave Rumbold, Ginger Carlisle, Jim Mercer, Dave Lindahl, Dan Hardman, and Steve Hansard were present.

Citizens wishing to be heard: None at this time.

New Business:

- A. Luke Leesman, with Midwestern Insurance Associates, presented new employee health insurance quotes for 2024. The purpose of this meeting was to make sure the Council understands the options and the savings to the City while giving all employees good coverage. The packets were passed out with all the details.**

These quotes along with Hediger & Meyers BCBS quotes will be voted on at the December 19, 2023, Council Meeting under Ordinance 23/24-22.

Aldermen's reports: Ald. Jim Mercer, Sewer & R/O plants, reported he had a meeting with Leander Construction, Quick Electric, and Farnsworth Group. He wasn't happy with the work being done by Quick Electric and the delays in getting the job done at WWTP. Leander told Quick Electric that they will have the electrical work done by Dec. 28th. Since then, Jim found some wiring done incorrectly. He contacted Mike Lutz to make sure the prints were correct as Quick said they went by the prints. Most of this has been taken care of. He reported the R/O stopped working one day and they had to contact Britton Electric to get it running. Britton Electric will give Jim a quote for a new PLC, Programable Logic Computer, and Viewing Screen. He is expecting quotes from two companies for a new R/O system to compare the difference between replacing parts versus buying a new system. Five residents on the S.W. corner of town each have 1 leak inside their house in the last 2 weeks. They can smell Chlorine and wondered if that could have caused the leaks. He will have Steve Marvin, Manager of Water/Sewer, test their water.

Ald. Carlisle reported 400 N 7th has several very large bags of leaves in front of their yard. They just need to be told that we don't pick up leaves and give them the burn ordinance. She also thanked Ald. Mercer for all the work he's doing for the city.

The motion to adjourn was made by Ald. Mercer and seconded by Ald. Hansard. Voice votes all ayes and the Meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
